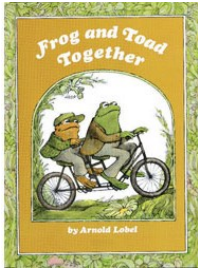


# Visual Learning Activities

## For Elementary Kids

### Read and Draw

As children are more comfortable with reading, it's time to focus on their reading comprehension skills. This is a simple activity that lets kids draw and write about what they read. The drawing and writing helps them turn the words they heard into images they can remember. It also helps focus their thinking so they can write about what they read.

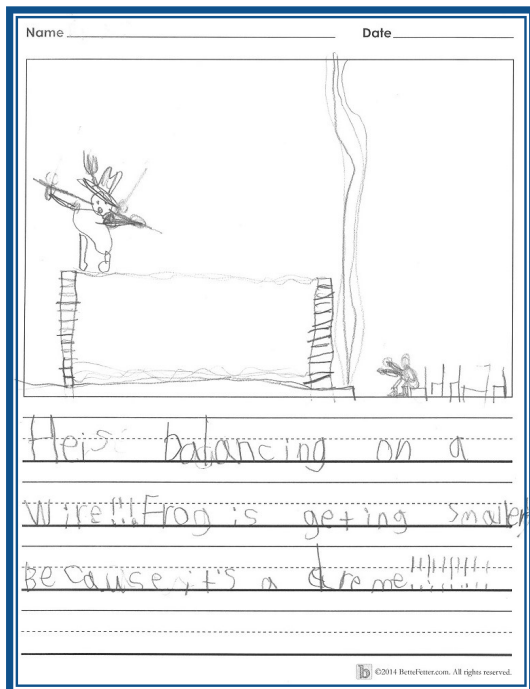


#### Materials Needed:

- A Passage to Read
- Story Paper
- Pencil for Drawing

#### Action:

- Have your child read for a little bit (10 minutes) either out loud or silently
- Give the child a piece of story paper
- Have the child draw a picture about what he just read
- Have your child tell you about their drawing
- Have the child write a couple sentences about the drawing.



#### Variations:

Younger kids – read to them and have them draw a picture based on the story.

As kids get older – they can read to you – then draw and write sentences.

Independent readers – can read the story or passage on their own and draw and write a few sentences.
